WHAT IS MINI-OLYMPICS?

Think of **MINI-OLYMPICS** as a recital. Your gymnast gets to perform skills and short routines composed of skills they've learned, or are working on in class. I will let the gymnasts know when it's their turn and I will help the gymnasts-either verbally or physically-with any skills within the routine. Once every gymnast has performed, there will be a short exhibition followed by the closing ceremonies.

DOES MY GYMNAST HAVE TO DO MINI-OLYMPICS?

No. **MINI-OLYMPICS** is just a fun event that gives the gymnasts a chance to show off all of the great things that they're learning in class. However, we do encourage & recommend each gymnast to participate. **Please call if you choose not to show up.**

WHAT IF MY GYMNAST CAN'T DO ALL OF THE SKILLS IN THE ROUTINE?

All gymnasts, even those within the same class, are at different skill levels. So it's o.k. if a gymnast isn't able to perform a skill in the routine. The gymnasts have the option to skip the skill, or get a spot.

IF MINI-OLYMPICS IS "NON-COMPETITIVE", WHY ARE THE ROUTINES JUDGED?

Many gymnasts have a desire to be on the Team sometime in their future, so, to give the performers a small taste of what advanced level gymnasts experience, (besides just performing in front of a crowd), we have ceremonial judges at the **MINI-OLYMPICS**. The score your child receives is based entirely -but not harshly- on presentation, listening, and following instructions.

WHAT SHOULD MY GYMNAST WEAR?

The performing gymnast should wear their show leotards, (no shorts or T-Shirt allowed). Long hair should be up and secure. Please remove any loose or dangly jewelry and dispose of gum or candies.
